

2025 Venue Hire Prices

We have put together two different venue hire packages. For dry hire with no bar open or staffed it is assumed no alcohol will be consumed, only alcohol purchased from us is allowed to be consumed on the premises. The second package includes the bar fully open and staffed.

We work with excellent caterers that can cater for most dietary and cultural tastes however we do allow outside caterers to be brought in when our caterers cannot cater, for example, for Halal or specific cultural catering requirements. The caterer must provide all staff, crockery, cutlery and table linen. Specific requirements for the caterer will be discussed with each couple directly.

A minimum of 80 guests is required for mid-week bookings and 100 for weekends. A minimum pre-order on the bar of £1,500 is required.

Booking your Wedding

First you will need to choose your wedding date and we will provisionally hold it for two weeks. If you decide to go ahead, we will send you the booking contract to be signed and returned with the deposit of £1,500. Six months before your wedding 50% of the balance is due with the final balance payment due (plus a £500 security deposit) 4 weeks before your wedding date. At the same time as booking your wedding you should book your registrar or church. We have a list of recommended suppliers if you need any help or advice.

Extra Information

Our capacity is 150 seated. We have 11 tables that seat 12 and 2 that seat 10. All confetti used must be biodegradable and is only allowed in the garden, if confetti is used outside a £50 clean up charge will be deducted from your security deposit. No confetti canons are permitted. Confetti inside will result in the loss of your full deposit. Fireworks are not allowed at the venue at any time.

Any alcohol consumed on the premises other than purchased from the venue will incur a charge to your security deposit.

Guests may be asked to submit to a search, if they refuse they may be asked to leave.

Any unauthorised alcohol found will be confiscated and disposed of.

Please communicate this to your guests to avoid any embarrassment on your day.

Damage: the organisers of the event are responsible for the actions and behaviour of their guests and any damages, losses and additional cleaning incurred will be deducted from the security deposit.

Please ensure all caterers have read and understood the catering agreement, use of the kitchen is included but caterers are expected to bring their own pots, pans cutlery, crockery, cutlery, cleaning equipment and take their rubbish with them.
